Enforcement

Enforcement of the Code of Student Conduct is the responsibility of the Office of Student Conduct. The Office of Student Conduct will investigate and adjudicate all allegations of student misconduct. The Office of Student Conduct will also provide support and resources to students who have been affected by student misconduct.

Student Complaints

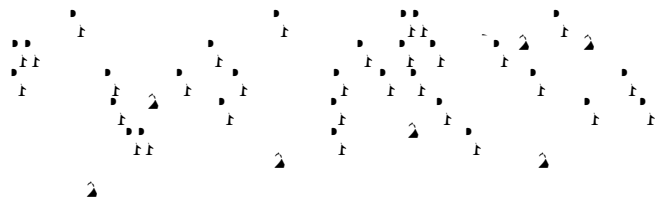


