Amendment to Resolution 2024.04.03.7A Gen Ed and Grad Requirement Outcomes Revision for Title 5 and Cal-GETC Alignment

Whereas, on April 3, 2024, the Academic Senate Executive Council approved the Curriculum Committee's creation of GE (Title 5) and graduation requirement learning outcomes for Currl Qunet implementation starting fall '24;

Whereas, in Resolution 2024.04.03.7A outcomes A and B for Area 3A (Arts) use the conjunction "and":

- A. Explore and express the arts socially and culturally.
- B. Analyze the historical and social contexts of works of art.
- C. Evaluate the creative expression of self and others;

Whereas, on May 15, 2024, the Curriculum Committee was reviewing its first new A rea 3A course outline, the newly proposed A RTS 113, and discussed that "and" in those two new 3A outcomes need to be "or" to address learning involving the creation of art or the examination of art, as was originally intended, not necessarily both concurrently;

Whereas, it's vital that this change be made in Currl Qunet immediately while other updates are happening and before the use of "and" creates tension and anxiety in future outline modifications; therefore, be it

Resolved, that "or" replace "and" in outcomes A and B used in the mapping of A rea 3A (A rts) and implemented in CurrlQunet:

- E. A nalyze the historical and social contexts of works of art. Evaluate the creative expression of self or others.

Whereas, those who attended Emdin's keynote on February 20th 2024 each received a copy of the book from OSE and the presentation received rave reviews from those in attendance; therefore be it
